

Folwell School, Performing Arts Magnet School Uniform Policy

A school dress standard helps promote safety, ease of identification, equity, school pride, good behavior and the development of community. A school uniform presents a professional image and distinguishes our students when they participate in community activities. Our policy provides students and families with clear expectations about how every student uniform must appear, as outlined below.

Tops

Solid black or white collared shirts (polo or button-up; short or long-sleeved; free from any logos)

Solid black or white sweaters

No hooded tops

Must be tucked in to bottoms

Bottoms

Solid black or khaki pants (no jeans, leggings, pajamas, sweatpants or athletic pants)

Solid black or khaki skirts or dresses with solid white or black tights

Solid black or khaki shorts (length must be past the fingertips when arms are at the student's side)

Must be worn at the waist (no sagging or dragging)

Folwell Gear

Folwell school shirts may be worn at any time. (Includes: athletics, arts, Community Education-sponsored and MPS-sponsored/Folwell events-related apparel)

Headwear

Headbands are allowed; bandanas are not

No hats

All Students must not wear

Clothing that is immodest or worn inappropriately

Monitoring of uniform policy

1. As students enter the building each morning, staff will check student attire. Those not in school uniform will be sent directly to 174.
2. Homeroom/first period teachers will check student attire. Those not in school uniform will be sent to 174.

Noncompliance to the uniform policy may result in (but is not limited to):

1st Offense: Warning will be given, infraction will be documented, and student will be given a change of clothes for the day. At the end of the day student will return the "rented" uniform to 174.

2nd Offense: Infraction will be documented and parents/guardians will be notified to bring a change of clothes for the student.

3rd Offense: Parents/guardians will be notified and meeting will be arranged to address noncompliance with uniform policy; student will be issued a lunch, after school, or Saturday detention.
